Deborah Steward has lived through every parent's nightmare. In October 2010, she and her husband found their son Daniel dead of an apparent prescription drug overdose. Drowning in grief, unable to sleep or eat, she at first wishes only to follow Daniel out of this life. And then she hears from him. The first message comes in just days after his death, e-mailed to her by a clairaudient friend. As more messages follow, some conveyed through other friends and family members and some directly from Daniel to his parents, she begins to keep a detailed record of the signs and means of communication that her son employs to convince his family that he is still with them and that he wants to help them recover from this worst of all losses. Told by his mother, *Cardinal at My Window* is Daniel's story, from his early teenage years when signs of an anxiety disorder first surfaced to his last months when his mother began to suspect that what they had thought was anxiety might be something far worse. Her fear that he might be bipolar sent her on a search for help, but it was too late. While this is Daniel's story, it is also the story of his mother's journey from despair to a belief that death is not the end of the journey for her or her son.

This volume commemorated the 50th anniversary of the installation (1941) of Eric Milner-White as Dean of York. He undertook the restoration of the Minster glass after the War, added considerably to the furnishings and fabrics in the building, and promoted the development of the distinguished musical tradition of York. The improvement of the Minster Library was among his major contributions. His permanent influence on York was not confined to his work for the life and worship of the Minster, but extended to the Diocese and Province.

The Mortal Jigsaw puzzle follows the struggles of a heroic urban vice principal, as he attempts to control a large high school teetering on the verge of chaos. While attempting to place the gratuitous carnage and depravity of the inner city into perspective, Mr. Perez accidentally stumbles upon an interdisciplinary mind control plan which draws upon religion, politics, economics, psychology, marketing, history, and the occult. Alarmed by his findings, Mr. Perez warns his community of their pending doom, only to be hunted down by the very debt cattle whom he tries to save from oblivion. In the end, both his community and his nation are

condemned to fall under this nefarious plot, as this educators quixotic mission abruptly ends with an ominous knock on his front door.

### **The New-England Courant**

This book describes how parents lose, find, or relocate spiritual anchors after the death of their child. It describes how ordinary people reconstruct their lives after their foundations have shifted, and how they make sense of their world after one of their centers of meaning has been removed. Klass grounds his descriptions of spirituality in his scholarly study of comparative religions, and in his two decades studying the lives of bereaved parents. He argues that continuing bonds with their dead children can give parents a new transcendent reality. Deceased children, like saints or bodhisattvas, can offer a bridge between the profane and sacred worlds, support parents as they find meaning in a world made forever poorer, and bind together a community adequate to parents' grief. The book reports Klass's clinical practice and his work as advisor to a bereaved parents self-help support group.
